Mission Statement

In order to decide on its strategy ahead the plenary, the Group coordinates the parliamentary work of its Members in the twenty standing parliamentary committees.

The Group takes all the decisions relating to the Group's positions in plenary session, under the direction of the Chief Whip and EPP Vice-Chair in charge of the Parliamentary work. To achieve this, Chief Whip ensures the legislative coordination in close cooperation with Chairman of the EPP Group, the Vice Chairs in charge of the Permanent Working Groups and the Coordinators of the EPP Group in each parliamentary committee.

In this field, the Chief Whip organises the Group and the Coordinators' meetings, leads the debates and the discussions within the Group and manages the Group's position during the plenary votes.

Chief Whip is also responsible on behalf of the Group for the annual Commission Work Programme (CWP), which constitutes the backbone of the legislative agenda of the European Parliament. For this ongoing yearly exercise, Chief Whip coordinates the Group's priorities in order to maximise the EPP Group influence over the contents of the legislative agenda for the forthcoming year.
